7	ADDITIONAL INFORMATION THAT MAY BE REQUIRED; AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO ACCEPT AN AWARD AND TO
8	SIGN ANY AND ALL DOCUMENTATION THAT MAY BE REQUIRED IN CONNECTION WITH THE GRANT APPLICATION OR AWARD,
9	SUBJECT TO REVIEW AND APPROVAL FOR LEGAL SUFFICIENCY BY THE OFFICE OF THE COUNTY ATTORNEY; AUTHORIZING THE
10	COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO TAKE ALL ADMINISTRATIVE AND BUDGETARY ACTIONS NECESSARY TO IMPLEMENT THE GRANT;
11	AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

13	WHEREAS, the Secretary of the U.S. Department of Transportation is authorized to
14	make grants for transit projects; and
15	WHEREAS, the Federal Transit Administration allocated \$26 billion in American
16	Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds to help public transportation systems respond to Coronavirus
17	Disease 2019, NOW, THEREFORE,
18	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD
19	COUNTY, FLORIDA:
20	Section 1. The Director of the Transportation Department is authorized to sign and
21	submit a grant application to the U.S. Department of Transportation pursuant to 49 U.S.C.
22	Section 5307 of the Federal Transit Act for Fiscal Year 2021 ARPA Urbanized Area Formula
23	Funds, in the amount of Eighty-seven Million Five Hundred Fifty-five Thousand Five Hundred

Forty-seven Dollars (\$87,555,547), to help Broward County Transit respond to Coronavirus
 Disease 2019.

3 Section 2. The Director of the Transportation Department, or designee, is
4 authorized to furnish all information that the U.S. Department of Transportation, Federal
5 Transit Administration may require in connection with the application.

Section 3. The County Administrator is authorized to accept a grant award, unless
this Resolution is specifically rescinded, and to sign any and all documentation that may be
required in connection with the grant application, subject to review and approval for legal
sufficiency by the Office of the County Attorney.

Section 4. The County Administrator is authorized to take all necessaryadministrative and budgetary actions to implement the grant.
