FLORIDA, 3 SUPPORTING THE BROWARD METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION'S PROJECT TO ENHANCE BICYCLE AND 4 PEDESTRIAN SAFETY ALONG CORAL SPRINGS DRIVE **FROM** RAMBLEWOOD **DRIVE** TO WILES ROAD: 5 BROWARD COUNTY AS THE RECOGNIZING RESPONSIBLE FOR THE DESIGN, CONSTRUCTION, AND 6 CONSTRUCTION ADMINISTRATION; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE. 7 8 9 WHEREAS, the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization ("MPO") has funds under its Transportation Improvement Program to design and construct bicycle lanes and 10 11 sidewalks along Coral Springs Drive from Ramblewood Drive to Wiles Road ("Project"), 12 within the City of Coral Springs ("City"); 13 WHEREAS, the road right-of-way within the limits of the Project is functionally 14 classified as a Broward County ("County") road, which requires the County to maintain or 15 coordinate the maintenance of the road right-of-way; 16 WHEREAS, the MPO and Florida Department of Transportation ("FDOT") require 17 a resolution from the County supporting the Project in order to establish funding eligibility 18 under the Transportation Improvement Program using federal funds; 19 WHEREAS, federally funded projects off the state highway system are delivered 20 using the federally mandated Local Agency Program ("LAP") process: 21 WHEREAS, the County will be the agency responsible for the design, construction, and construction administration of the Project under LAP; 22 23 WHEREAS, the County collaborated with the MPO and the City to develop the

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Project;

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WHEREAS, the Project will further the County's complete streets efforts while furthering the County's goal to "support the development, design, and construction of sustainable, multi-modal transportation facilities throughout the County, to meet the demands of residents, travelers, and businesses", NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

- The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed Section 1. as being true and correct and are made part of this Resolution.
- The Board of County Commissioners of Broward County, Florida Section 2. ("Board"), supports the Project, which will improve conditions for bicyclists and pedestrians along Coral Springs Drive from Ramblewood Drive to Wiles Road within the Project.
- Section 3. The County will be the agency responsible for the Project's design, construction, and construction administration.
- Section 4. County will continue to maintain or coordinate the maintenance of the road right-of-way after the Project's completion.

Section 5. Severability.

If any portion of this Resolution is determined by any Court to be invalid, the invalid portion will be stricken, and such striking will not affect the validity of the remainder of this Resolution. If any Court determines that this Resolution, in whole or in part, cannot be legally applied to any individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance, such
