AMENDMENT NO. 3

Amendment No. 3 to agreement between Broward County and Triangle Services of Florida, Inc. for Janitorial Services for Various County Facilities (Broward County Judicial Complex West Building, Bridge 4 and Bridge 5 - Contract No. 14), Agreement No. R1214808P1 (the "Agreement").

This is the amendment to the agreement between Broward County, hereinafter referred to as "County", and Triangle Services of Florida, Inc., hereinafter referred to as "Vendor", collectively referred to as "the Parties".

Recitals

Whereas, on February 17, 2016, the Parties entered into Agreement No. R1214808P1 for provision of Janitorial Services for Various County Facilities (Broward County Judicial Complex West Building, Bridge 4 and Bridge 5 - Contract No. 14); and

Whereas, the Agreement is scheduled to expire on May 31, 2021; and

Whereas, on February 6, 2017, the Parties entered into Amendment No. 1 to the Agreement, to revise the initial term of the Agreement and amended the Facility Group Identification / Details, Broward County Judicial Complex West Building, Bridge 4 and Bridge 5 - Contract No. 14 (Move In Transition Proposal). The overall threshold amount was increased by \$384,020; and

Whereas, the Parties entered into the Agreement for provision of janitorial services. The Agreement requires that Vendor, a "covered employer", comply with the Living Wage Ordinance, Sections 26-100 through 26-105, including that Vendor pay all of its employees providing "covered services" as defined in the Living Wage Ordinance, a living wage. The Agreement also requires that Vendor comply with all applicable federal, state, and local laws, codes, ordinances, rules, and regulations; and

Whereas, on December 11, 2018, the Board of County Commissioners amended the Living Wage Ordinance to increase the living wage rate to at least \$13.27 per hour with qualifying health care benefit amounts of at least \$1.63 per hour, or at least \$14.90 per hour without health care benefits, adjusted annually as provided in the Living Wage Ordinance; and

Whereas, on March 27, 2019, the Parties entered into Amendment No. 2 to the Agreement, to bring the Agreement into compliance with the County's Living Wage Ordinance, Section 26-100 through 26-105 and to modify pricing for Vendor's services and increase the overall threshold amount by \$111,609; and

Whereas, due to the living wage price adjustment, the effective date of the living wage price adjustment is April 1, 2019; and

Whereas, County has determined that a change to the prices, terms and/or conditions are necessary and in the County's best interest; and

Whereas, Vendor has provided and the County has accepted the change as described in Section 1 below, all in accordance with the Broward County Procurement Code, 21.47, and this amendment to the Agreement incorporates the results of such accepted change(s); therefore, in consideration of the mutual terms, conditions, promises, and covenants set forth herein, the Parties agree as follows:

Section 1:

- 1. The truth and accuracy of each "Whereas" clause set forth above is acknowledged by the Parties and the recitals contained in the "Whereas" clauses are incorporated herein.
- 2. The Agreement shall be modified to add the services as displayed in Exhibit 1, Cleaning and Electrostatic Spray (COVID-19), Scope of Services, Section B.
- 3. The response time for the cleaning and electrostatic spray services must be in accordance with the Vendor's response as displayed in Exhibit 1, Cleaning and Electrostatic Spray (COVID-19), Scope of Services, Section C. Response Time (Exhibit 1).
- 4. The cleaning and electrostatic spray services are to be provided only upon the request by the County and issuance of a Purchase Order. The services will mitigate a County facility and/or section for COVID-19.
- 5. The Vendor's personnel must wear face shields and rubber gloves when transferring any concentrated products. All personnel handling the diluted products must always wear protective gloves (latex/neoprene, etc) and safety glasses at a minimum.
- 6. This Amendment No. 3 increases the total not-to-exceed amount of the Agreement by \$700,975.68 for a new total not-to-exceed amount of \$9,798,290.76.
- 7. This Amendment No. 3 shall be effective on the date of fully executed signatures.
- 8. Except as provided in this Amendment No. 3, the terms and conditions set forth in the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.

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- 9. In the event of any conflict or ambiguity between this Amendment No. 3 and the Agreement, the Parties agree that this Amendment No. 3 shall control.
- 10. This Amendment No. 3 may be executed in multiple originals, and may be executed in counterparts, each of which shall be deemed to be an original, but all of which taken together, shall constitute one and the same agreement.

Cleaning and Electrostatic Spray (COVID-19) Janitorial Agreement/s

Purpose

To provide a quote for cleaning and electrostatic spray services to mitigate a County facility and/or section for COVID-19. These services are to be provided only upon the request by the County and issuance of a Purchase Order.

Scope of Services

Broward County is seeking electrostatic spray services, which consist of a cleaning method that atomizes cleaning solutions to produce an electrically charged spray to wrap around surfaces of all types for even coat of chemical application. As the chemical exits the electrostatic sprayer, a positive charge is discharged to allow the sanitizer and disinfectant to form a vector field or an electric charge to force an attraction to surfaces containing a negative charge.
