VI. SUMMARY DESCRIPTION:

The Broward Sheriff's Office supports this LETF request for ShotSpotter – Hallandale Beach. The City of Hallandale Beach intends to install ShotSpotter in a one square mile area. ShotSpotter is an outdoor acoustic gunshot detection system that uses advanced technology to calculate the precise location a gun is fired, which is then transmitted to law enforcement on a GPS map in their car's computers, cell phones, and command center, thus allowing officers to respond to an incident in seconds.

The ShotSpotter Initiative's goals are to:

1. Respond to firearms related crimes in an expedient manner. 80% of all "shots fired" calls are never reported to law enforcement
2. 2- Arrest perpetrators responsible for firearms related crimes
3. 3- Apply lifesaving first aid to victims of gun violence at the scene of incidents
4. 4-Collect firearms ballistic evidence at crime scenes for analysis and comparison to other crime scenes.
5. Enhance community relationship


