SUBJECT: Proposed Ordinance Amending Section 22½-6D of the Broward County Code of Ordinances, Relating

to Port Everglades Business Permits

Summary

The proposed ordinance makes various changes to section 22½-6D of the Broward County Code of Ordinances giving the Board options to waive, prorate, modify fees, and modify expiration dates during a declared state or local emergency. Currently the fees are \$250 for business permits and \$15 per vehicle for a decal to operate at Port Everglades. In fiscal year 2019 the County collected \$154,500 in business permit revenue, and \$62,655 in decal revenue, for a total of \$217,155 in revenues.

Fiscal Impact

The fiscal impact of the proposed ordinance cannot be determined. Without knowing the specific modifications the Board would make to the permit fees, the fiscal impact cannot be estimated at this time.
