Thermo Air, Inc., Airmatic Controls, Inc., MAM A/C and Refrigeration Co. and AJ Air Services, Inc. are all certified County Business Enterprise (CBE) firms and in compliance with the CBE Reserve Program requirements of this solicitation.

Temptrol A/C, Inc. is a non-certified CBE firm and therefore, did not meet the CBE Reserve program requirements of the solicitation.

Pursuant to Section 1-81.3(f) of the Broward County Business Opportunity Act of 2012 (the Act) as amended, when a CBE reserve is established in connection with a County solicitation, CBEs and non-CBEs may respond to the solicitation. If a CBE with capacity to perform the work submits a responsive and responsible bid or proposal, the work will be awarded to the CBE that submits the lowest responsive and responsible bid or the highest-ranked responsive and responsible proposal. If no CBE with capacity to perform the work submits a responsive and responsible bid, a non-CBE with the lowest responsive and responsible bid or the highest-ranked responsive and responsible proposal, as applicable, may be awarded the contract with at least a twenty-five percent (25%) CBE goal (unless the CBE goal is waived or otherwise modified by Board action), or the county may reject all bids and responses submitted.
