History of Electronic Data, Inc. System and Services Agreement For Consultant Services for consulting services and upgrades to the existing Maximo Enterprise Asset Management System At Broward County's Fort Lauderdale-Hollywood International Airport

In 2016, the Broward County Aviation Department ("BCAD") obtained an on-site needs assessment from Electronic Data, Inc. ("EDI") for a large upgrade project relating to Broward County's Fort Lauderdale-Hollywood International Airport ("FLL") asset management. On August 22, 2017, BCAD received an assessment report from EDI detailing recommendations including but not limited to assets, inventory control, work orders, and maintenance planning.

On April 17, 2018, the Director of Purchasing approved a Most Reasonable Source Memorandum for EDI to provide the proposed services, including additional modules and functionalities recommended based on the needs assessment performed by EDI.

On October 23, 2018 (Item No 16), the Broward County Board of County Commissioners ("Board") approved a System and Services Agreement ("Agreement") between Broward County ("County") and EDI to implement EDI's Enterprise Strategic Asset Management (eSAM) system and to upgrade BCAD's existing Maximo Enterprise Asset Management System ("Maximo System"), provide training and consulting services for an initial two-year term, with an option to renew for up to three additional one-year terms to be approved by the Director of Purchasing, in the total not-to exceed amount of \$1,478,000, inclusive of up to \$350,000 for Optional Services.

On June 29, 2020, the Director of Purchasing approved a Most Reasonable Source Memorandum for the acquisition of EDI Atlas Work Management Licenses, Software Subscription & Support, to provide a mobile solution to replace paper work orders with airport-specific functionality to meet BCAD system requirements.
