In the event of an alleged breach of any provision of this Agreement, a nonbreaching Party shall provide written notice of the breach to the alleged breaching Party with a copy to the other Party. If the breach is not cured within 30 days after written notice of the breach, this Agreement may be terminated for cause by the nonbreaching Party that provided notice of breach upon 10 days' prior written notice.

For Convenience:

This Agreement may also be terminated for convenience by County or City by providing at least 30 days' prior written notice to the other Parties. If County or City erroneously, improperly, or unjustifiably terminates for cause, such termination shall, to the full extent permissible under applicable law, be deemed a termination for convenience, which shall be effective 30 days after such notice of termination for cause is provided.

16. Deliverables, milestones or scope of this action:

PACA shall submit to County and City a calendar quarterly financial report consisting of a statement of net position, a statement of revenue and expenses, a working capital statement, a cash flow schedule and forecast, and a schedule of all operating expenditures that were made from any funds received and disbursed during the calendar quarter for which the report is prepared. Such quarterly reports shall be submitted within 45 days after the end of each calendar quarter. PACA shall also prepare and submit an annual financial report with the same details as the quarterly reports (except that the annual report will provide details for the entire fiscal year) to County and City within 120 days after the end of the Term. PACA's obligations under this section shall survive the expiration of the Term.
