1 **RESOLUTION NO. 2021-**2 RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA. 3 WAIVING SECTION 18.43(D) OF THE BROWARD COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE CODE TO CONSIDER NAMING 4 COUNTY-OWNED ROAD AFTER CONGRESSMAN ALCEE L. HASTINGS; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND 5 AN EFFECTIVE DATE. 6 (Sponsored by Commissioner Dale V.C. Holness) 7 8 WHEREAS, Section 18.43 of the Broward County Administrative Code 9 ("Administrative Code") sets out the policy of the Board of County Commissioners 10 ("Board") for naming property owned by Broward County ("County"); 11 WHEREAS, Section 18.43(d) of the Administrative Code provides that property 12 owned by the County, including County roads, may be named after persons who have 13 passed away following a minimum 90-day waiting period; 14 WHEREAS, Congressman Alcee L. Hastings ("Congressman Hastings") is a 15 person who made numerous significant contributions to the County, including as a civil 16 rights leader; 17 WHEREAS, Congressman Hastings sadly passed away on April 6, 2021, after a 18 life dedicated to public service; and 19 WHEREAS, the Board desires to waive the provisions of Section 18.43(d) of the 20 Administrative Code in order to consider renaming the portion of NW 8th Street from 21 NW 27th Avenue to NW 31st Avenue located in the Broward Municipal Services District 22 ("County Road") in honor of Congressman Hastings on June 1, 2021, NOW, THEREFORE 23 24

Section 1. The Board hereby waives the provisions of Section 18.43(d) of the
Administrative Code in order to consider renaming the County Road in honor of
Congressman Hastings.
