2	A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY
3	COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, PERTAINING TO THE PARKS AND RECREATION DIVISION AND TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT:
4	DIVISION AND TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT; AMENDING SECTIONS 6.23, 6.117, 13.91, AND 21.73 OF THE BROWARD COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE CODE
5	("ADMINISTRATIVE CODE") TO AUTHORIZE THE PARKS AND RECREATION DIVISION AND TRANSPORTATION
6	DEPARTMENT TO PERFORM CERTAIN CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT, CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT AND
7	ADMINISTRATION, AND OTHER FUNCTIONS RELATED TO THE MAINTENANCE AND CONSTRUCTION OF
8	COUNTY FACILITIES; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, INCLUSION IN THE ADMINISTRATIVE
9	CODE, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
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11	WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners (the "Board") wishes to amend
12	various sections of the Broward County Administrative Code ("Administrative Code") to
13	authorize the Parks and Recreation Division (the "Division") and the Transportation
14	Department (the "Department") to: (i) develop their own capital improvement programs;
15	(ii) perform construction management and administration for their respective projects
16	including architectural, engineering, and related professional services; and (iii) approve
17	change orders pursuant to Chapter 21 of the Administrative Code; and
18	WHEREAS, the Board finds it is reasonable and in the best interest of the public
19	to revise Sections 6.23, 6.117, 13.91, and 21.73 of the Administrative Code to authorize
20	the Division and the Department to perform their own capital improvement, construction
21	management and administration, and other related functions, NOW, THEREFORE,
22	
23	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
24	BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

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1	Section 1. Section 6.23 of the Broward County Administrative Code is hereby				
2	amended to read as follows:				
3	6.23. Functions; Responsibilities.				
4	The Facilities Management Division shall:

6	b. Implement the general maintenance and custodial program for all County				
7	facilities, excluding Water and Wastewater Services, Waste and Recycling				
8	Services, the Aviation Department, Port Everglades Department, the				
9	Transportation Department, and the Parks and Recreation Division, which				
10	have their own internal capabilities.

13	Section 2. Section 6.117 of the Broward County Administrative Code is hereby				
14	amended to read as follows:				
15	6.117. Functions; Responsibilities.				
16	The Construction Management Division shall:

18	c. Through the expertise of the County Architect, Pprovide architectural				
19	management services and technical assistance to all County agencies				
20	except the Aviation and, Port Everglades, and Transportation Departments,				
21	and the Parks and Recreation Division through the expertise of the County				
22	Architect.				
23	d. Unless otherwise provided by law, provide contract administration of				
24	construction and major modification contracts for the projects to be used by				
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1		the constitutional officers, the County Administrator's Office, and other
2		projects that are not solely for the use of or clearly the responsibility of the
3		Aviation and, Port Everglades, or Transportation Departments or the Parks
4		and Recreation Division. The Construction Management Division may
5		provide management services to State agencies by written agreement
6		when appropriate funds are provided.

8	Sectio	on 3. Section 13.91 of the Broward County Administrative Code is hereby
9	amended to	read as follows:
10	13.91. Fund	tions; Responsibilities.
11	The P	arks and Recreation Division shall:

13	<u>p.</u>	Develop, implement, and maintain a capital improvement program for the
14		Division.
15	<u>q.</u>	Provide planning and design services for the Division under the direct
16		management of a professional engineer or architect with the following
17		minimum qualifications: (i) eligible for the professional licensing required by
18		the State of Florida; (ii) expertise in construction management; and (iii)
19		considerable progressively responsible management experience.
20	<u>r.</u>	Provide architecture, engineering, and related construction, professional,
21		and general services for the Division by the Division's staff or through
22		contracted services.
23	<u>S.</u>	Provide project management and contract administration for construction,
24		professional, general, and other service contracts for the Division.
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Section 4. Section 21.73 of the Broward County Administrative Code is hereby
 amended to read as follows:

3 **21.73.** Right of Construction Contract Change.

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5 C. Change Orders. The County shall have the right, based on a clause 6 contained in each construction contract, to require changes in quantities, additions or 7 deletions of work, or other changes within the original intent of the contract. Each construction contract shall have an initial amount budgeted for change orders equal to 8 9 five percent (5%) of the total contract amount which that can be administratively 10 approved. Any larger percentage must be approved by the Board of County 11 Commissioners when the corresponding additional allowance exceeds ten percent (10%) 12 of the original contract amount or \$100,000. The Director of Purchasing may approve a 13 change order allowance increase up to no greater than ten percent (10%) of the original 14 contract amount or \$100,000, whichever is less. All changes to construction contracts 15 must be approved in advance in accordance with the value of the change order or the 16 calculated value of the time extension. All contract change orders of \$250,000.00 or more 17 shall be approved, in advance, by the Board. The approval of change orders under this 18 amount is hereby delegated to the Director of Aviation, the Director of Port Everglades, 19 the Director of Parks and Recreation, the Chief Transportation Officer, and the Director 20 of Public Works for their respective projects. The Director of Aviation, the Director of Port 21 Everglades, the Director of Parks and Recreation, the Chief Transportation Officer, and 22 the Director of Public Works shall promulgate regulations through the County Internal 23 Policies and Procedures Manual or the Administrative Code prior to delegation of any 24 change order approval authority to their staff. All construction change orders shall be

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submitted to the Office of the Director of Aviation, the Director of Port Everglades, <u>the</u>
<u>Director of Parks and Recreation, the Chief Transportation Officer</u>, or the Director of
Public Works, as applicable, complete with explanations, back-up information, and a
detailed breakdown of charges for review and recommendation for approval. All change
orders must contain the reason for the change and provide sufficient documentation to
verify the reasonableness of any time extensions granted or prices charged in the change
order.

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Section 5. <u>Severability</u>.

If any portion of this Administrative Code Resolution is determined by any court to
be invalid, the invalid portion will be stricken, and such striking will not affect the validity
of the remainder of this Administrative Code Resolution. If any court determines that this
Administrative Code Resolution, in whole or in part, cannot be legally applied to any
individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance, such determination will not affect the
applicability of this Administrative Code Resolution to any other individual, group, entity,
property, or circumstance.

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Section 6. Inclusion in the Broward County Administrative Code.

It is the intention of the Board of County Commissioners that the provisions of this
Administrative Code Resolution become part of the Broward County Administrative Code
as of the effective date. The sections of this Administrative Code Resolution may be
renumbered or relettered and the word "resolution" may be changed to "section," "article,"

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1	or such other appropriate word or phrase to the extent necessary in order to accomplish			
2	such intention.
