Rich) 6 7 WHEREAS, the Public Square is the place where matters involving governance 8 are discussed and decided; 9 WHEREAS, the Public Square in the process of local government is primarily the City Hall or County Commission Chamber, the public place where legislators 10 execute their constitutionally mandated duties and responsibilities, and the place where 11 12 the execution of these duties and responsibilities is on public display; 13 WHEREAS, civility by commissioners and councilpersons in the execution of their 14 legislative duties and responsibilities fosters respect, kindness, and thoughtfulness 15 between commissioners and councilpersons, one to the other, and naturally results in the 16 efforts of such actions to be directed to issues and not to cause personal ill will; 17 WHEREAS, civility by commissioners and councilpersons promotes civil behavior 18 between citizens, one to the other; 19 WHEREAS, civility between commissioners and councilpersons promotes 20 thoughtful debate and discussion of legislative issues, resulting in better policy; 21 WHEREAS, civility between citizens promotes thoughtful debate of legislative 22 issues, resulting in a more informed electorate: 23 WHEREAS, civility between commissioners and councilpersons is in keeping with 24 the democratic model of self-governance as envisioned by the Founders;

WHEREAS, civility between commissioners and councilpersons presents an opportunity to set a positive example of conduct; and

WHEREAS, civility between commissioners and councilpersons is possible if each legislator remembers that he or she represents not himself or herself but the constituents of his or her district, city or county, so the conduct of a legislator is a reflection of his or her constituents, NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The Broward County Board of County Commissioners ("Board") endorses the concept of Civility in the Public Square as a means of conducting legislative duties and responsibilities.

Section 2. The Board encourages the citizens of Broward County to be civil in discussions and debates of matters under consideration in the Public Square.
