RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA. **ENCOURAGING** BROWARD COUNTY SUSPEND **PARTNERS** TO DIRECT COMMERCIAL PASSENGER FLIGHTS BETWEEN FORT LAUDERDALE HOLLYWOOD INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT AND AREAS WITH SUBSTANTIAL COMMUNITY SPREAD OF COVID-19: **PROVIDING** FOR SEVERABILITY EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, COVID-19, a respiratory illness caused by a virus that spreads rapidly from person to person and may result in serious illness or death, constitutes a clear and present threat to the lives, health, welfare, and safety of the people of Broward County;

WHEREAS, on March 1, 2020, Governor DeSantis declared a Public Health Emergency as a result of COVID-19, and on March 9, 2020, Governor DeSantis issued Executive Order 20-52, declaring a State of Emergency as a result of COVID-19;

WHEREAS, on March 13, 2020, President Trump declared a national emergency concerning COVID-19;

WHEREAS, on March 30, 2020, Governor DeSantis executed Executive Order 20-89, ordering Miami-Dade County, Broward County, Palm Beach County, and Monroe County to restrict access to businesses and facilities deemed nonessential pursuant to the guidelines established by Miami-Dade County Emergency Order 07-20, as modified by subsequent amendments and orders prior to March 30, 2020;

WHEREAS, on April 1, 2020, Governor DeSantis issued Executive Order 20-91, ordering all persons in Florida to limit their movements and personal interactions outside

their homes to only those necessary to obtain or provide essential services or conduct essential activities;

WHEREAS, significant outbreaks of COVID-19 with substantial community spread have occurred and are continuing to occur in certain areas of the United States, including the New York tri-state area (New York, New Jersey, and Connecticut), Louisiana, and Michigan;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Executive Orders 20-82 and 20-66, Governor DeSantis has directed all persons who enter the State of Florida from areas of substantial community spread of COVID-19 to isolate or quarantine for a period of fourteen (14) days; and

WHEREAS, in an effort to "flatten the curve" and limit the spread of COVID-19 within the State of Florida and the South Florida area, the Board of County Commissioners encourages its airline partners to suspend direct commercial passenger flights between the Fort Lauderdale-Hollywood International Airport and areas of substantial community spread such the New York tri-state area (New York, New Jersey, and Connecticut), Louisiana, and Michigan, NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The Recitals set forth in the preamble to this Resolution are incorporated by reference herein.

Section 2. The Broward County Board of County Commissioners encourages its airline partners at the Fort Lauderdale-Hollywood International Airport ("FLL") to suspend all direct commercial passenger flights between FLL and areas with substantial community spread of COVID-19, including flights from the New York tri-state area (New York, New Jersey, and Connecticut), Louisiana, and Michigan. This Resolution does not impact cargo flights or charter or private flights.

Section 3. <u>Severability</u>.

If any portion of this Resolution is determined by any court to be invalid, the invalid portion will be stricken, and such striking will not affect the validity of the remainder of this Resolution. If any court determines that this Resolution, in whole or in part, cannot be legally applied to any individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance, such determination will not affect the applicability of this Resolution to any other individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance.
