RESOLUTION OF THE **BOARD** OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY. FLORIDA AUTHORIZING THE CONVEYANCE OF COUNTY-OWNED REAL PROPERTY TO THE CITY OF **POMPANO BEACH** PURSUANT ("CITY") TO SECTION 125.38, FLORIDA STATUTES; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Broward County ("County") holds title to certain real property located in the City of Pompano Beach ("City") and identified as folio number 4942-0200-0040 ("Parcel"), which is more particularly described in the legal description within the quitclaim deed attached to and made a part of this Resolution as Attachment A ("Quitclaim Deed");

WHEREAS, Section 125.38, Florida Statutes, states that if "the state or any political subdivision or agency thereof, or any municipality of this state...should desire any real or personal property that may be owned by any county of this state or by its board of county commissioners, for public or community interest and welfare, then the...state or such political subdivision, agency, municipality...may apply to the board of county commissioners for a conveyance or lease of such property. Such board, if satisfied that such property is required for such use and is not needed for county purposes, may thereupon convey or lease the same at private sale to the applicant for such price, whether nominal or otherwise, as such board may fix, regardless of the actual value of such property. The fact of such application being made, the purpose for which such property is to be used, and the price or rent therefor shall be set out in a resolution duly adopted by such board";

1 WHEREAS, the City applied to the Board of County Commissioners of Broward 2 County, Florida ("Board") for the conveyance of the Parcel for right-of-way purposes ("Stated Purpose"); and 3 4 5 WHEREAS, the Board supports the use of the Parcel for the Stated Purpose, and 6 desires to approve and authorize the conveyance of the Parcel to City for the 7 Stated Purpose, NOW, THEREFORE, 8 9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF 10 BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA: 11 12 Section 1. The recitals set forth in the preamble to this Resolution are true, 13 accurate, and deemed incorporated by reference herein as though set forth in full 14 hereunder. 15 Section 2. The Board finds that (1) City applied to the Board for the conveyance 16 of the Parcel for the Stated Purpose in accordance with Section 125.38, Florida Statutes; 17 (2) the Stated Purpose promotes public or community interest and welfare; and (3) the 18 Parcel is required by City for the Stated Purpose and is not needed for County purposes. 19 Section 3. The Board authorizes the conveyance of the Parcel to City for the 20 Stated Purpose in exchange for the total price of Ten Dollars (\$10.00). 21 Section 4. The Board authorizes the Mayor or Vice-Mayor of the Board to 22 execute the Quitclaim Deed in the same form as Attachment A and authorizes the County 23 Administrator to attest to such execution.

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1 Section 5. The Quitclaim Deed shall be properly recorded in the 2 Public Records of Broward County, Florida. 3 Section 6. Severability. If any portion of this Resolution is determined by any court to be invalid, the invalid 4 portion will be stricken, and such striking will not affect the validity of the remainder of this 5 6 Resolution. If any court determines that this Resolution, in whole or in part, cannot be 7 legally applied to any individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance, such determination will not affect the applicability of this Resolution to any other individual, 8 9 group, entity, property, or circumstance. 10 Section 7. QUITCLAIM DEED

(Pursuant to Section 125.411 and Section 125.38, Florida Statutes)

THIS QUITCLAIM DEED, made this _____ day of ________, 2020, by BROWARD COUNTY, a political subdivision of the State of Florida ("Grantor"), whose address is 115 South Andrews Avenue, Fort Lauderdale, Florida 33301, and the City of Pompano Beach, a Florida municipal corporation ("Grantee"), whose address is 100 West Atlantic Boulevard, Pompano Beach, Florida 33060.

(The terms "Grantor" and "Grantee" as used herein shall refer to the respective parties, and the heirs, personal representatives, successors, and assigns of such parties.)

WITNESSETH:

That Grantor, for and in consideration of TEN DOLLARS (\$10.00) and other valuable consideration, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, does hereby remise, release, and quitclaim unto Grantee, its successors and assigns, forever, all of Grantor's rights, title, and interest, if any, in and to the following described lands, lying and being in Broward County, Florida, to wit:

All that portion of the South One-Half (S 1/2) of the West One-Half (W 1/2) of Government Lot 4, of Section 2, Township 49 South, Range 42 East, bounded as follows:

On the North by the North Line of the South One-Half (S 1/2) of said Government Lot 4;

On the East by a line 361.27 feet West of and parallel with the East line of the West One-Half (W 1/2) of said Government Lot 4;

On the West and the Southwest by the Easterly right-of-way line Southwest 12 Avenue as shown on the Plat of POMPANO TERMINAL, as recorded in Plat Book 54, Page 11, of the Public Records of Broward County, Florida.

Said lands containing 37,026 square feet, more or less.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same together with all and singular the appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining, and all the estate, right, title, interest, lien, equity, and claim whatsoever of the said Grantor, either in law or equity, to the only proper use, benefit, and behalf of the said Grantee forever.

THIS CONVEYANCE IS SUBJECT TO all zoning rules, regulations, and ordinances and other prohibitions imposed by any governmental authority with jurisdiction over the Property conveyed herein; existing public purpose utility and government easements and rights of way and other matters of record; and real estate taxes for this year 2020 and all subsequent years.
