2 A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY
3 COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA,
4 WAIVING SECTION 18.43(C) OF THE BROWARD COUNTY
5 ADMINISTRATIVE CODE TO CONSIDER NAMING A
6 COUNTY-OWNED ROAD AFTER JUDGE ZEBEDEE
7 WRIGHT, A LIVING PERSON, AND DR. KATHLEEN C.
8 WRIGHT; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND AN
9 EFFECTIVE DATE.

11 WHEREAS, Section 18.43 of the Broward County Administrative Code
12 (“Administrative Code”) sets out the policy of the Board of County Commissioners
13 (“Board”) for naming property owned by Broward County (“County”);

14 WHEREAS, Section 18.43(c) of the Administrative Code provides that property
15 owned by the County, including County roads, should not be named after living persons;

16 WHEREAS, Judge Zebedee Wright (“Judge Wright”) is a living person who has
17 made numerous significant contributions to the County, including as a civil rights attorney
18 and Broward County Court Judge; and

19 WHEREAS, the Board desires to waive the provisions of Section 18.43(c) of the
20 Administrative Code in order to consider renaming the portion of NW 6th Court from
21 NW 27th Avenue to NW 31st Avenue located in the Broward Municipal Services District
22 (“County Road”) in honor of Judge Wright and the late Dr. Kathleen C. Wright, NOW,
23 THEREFORE

24 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

1 Section 1. The Board hereby waives the provisions of Section 18.43(c) of the
2 Administrative Code in order to consider renaming the County Road in honor of Judge
3 Zebedee Wright and the late Dr. Kathleen C. Wright.

4 Section 2. Severability.

5 If any portion of this Resolution is determined by any court to be invalid, the invalid
6 portion will be stricken, and such striking will not affect the validity of the remainder of this
7 Resolution. If any court determines that this Resolution, in whole or in part, cannot be
8 legally applied to any individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance, such
9 determination will not affect the applicability of this Resolution to any other individual,
10 group, entity, property, or circumstance.

11 Section 3. Effective Date.

12 This Resolution is effective upon adoption.
