2021 March Municipal Elections \$375,300 request

- 5 municipalities have notified SOE of intent to hold an election simultaneously with the March Presidential Preference Primary
- Cities will reimburse County for 100% of the cost of these elections, \$375.3K estimate and fringes
- Participating cities could be:
 - Coconut Creek
 - Deerfield Beach
 - Hillsboro Beach
 - Miramar
 - Sea Ranch Lakes



November 2020 General Election \$14,733,000 request

- Does not include expenses for potential recounts
- SOE turnout projection is 75%
- 2017 turnout for last General Election was 71.55%
- FY17 request for November General Election was \$9.18M; actual expenses were \$9.06M
