The Office of Economic and Small Business Development (OESBD) has evaluated FG Construction LLC's CBE participation for Bridge and Miscellaneous Structures Repairs. This contract was awarded to FG Construction, LLC on March 12, 2019 for a three-year potential estimated amount of \$15,194,115. The Highway and Bridge Maintenance Division (HBMD) is requesting a \$2.5 million threshold increase to perform emergency work for County-owned bridges due to water damage caused by Tropical Storm Eta. This review is based on information provided by the requesting agency and the prime contractor, FG Construction, LLC.
