RESOLUTION NO. 2020-

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, PERTAINING TO THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR'S AUTHORITY TO ACCEPT DONATIONS; AMENDING SECTION 18.63 OF THE BROWARD COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE CODE ("ADMINISTRATIVE CODE"); AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, INCLUSION IN THE ADMINISTRATIVE CODE, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Section 18.63 of the Broward County Administrative Code ("Administrative Code") sets forth the procedures for the acceptance of donations made to Broward County ("County"); and

WHEREAS, the County desires to amend Section 18.63 to allow the County Administrator to accept certain donations to the County made by governmental entities or agencies, regardless of monetary value, NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Section 18.63 of the Broward County Administrative Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

18.63. Donations.

...

(b) Donations to Broward County of anything other than an interest in real property, which donations are either (a) valued at less than Ten Thousand Dollars

1 (\$10,000) or (b) donated by a governmental entity or agency, regardless of monetary
2 value, may be accepted by the County Administrator or designee. Monetary donations
3 shall be deposited into the appropriate trust or other account for safekeeping and
4 expenditure consistent with the terms of the donation, and donations of personal property
5 shall be used consistent with the terms of the donation.

7 Section 2. Severability.

8 If any portion of this Administrative Code Resolution is determined by any court to
9 be invalid, the invalid portion will be stricken, and such striking will not affect the validity
10 of the remainder of this Administrative Code Resolution. If any court determines that this
11 Administrative Code Resolution, in whole or in part, cannot be legally applied to any
12 individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance, such determination will not affect the
13 applicability of this Administrative Code Resolution to any other individual, group, entity,
14 property, or circumstance.

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16 Section 3. Inclusion in the Broward County Administrative Code.

17 It is the intention of the Board of County Commissioners that the provisions of this
18 Administrative Code Resolution become part of the Broward County Administrative Code
19 as of the effective date. The sections of this Administrative Code Resolution may be
20 renumbered or relettered and the word "resolution" may be changed to "section," "article,"
21 or such other appropriate word or phrase to the extent necessary in order to accomplish
22 such intention.

underscored type are additions.

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Section 4. Effective Date.

This Administrative Code Resolution is effective upon adoption.
