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5	GOVERNMENT FUNDING REQUEST WITH THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION FOR		
6	THE BEACH MANAGEMENT FUNDING ASSISTANCE PROGRAM; SUPPORTING PROJECTS FOR WHICH		
7	FUNDING IS REQUESTED; CONFIRMING BROWARD COUNTY'S INTENT AND ABILITY TO SERVE AS LOCAL		
8	SPONSOR AND FUND THE APPROPRIATE LOCAL SHARE OF PROJECTS; IDENTIFYING THE SOURCE OF COUNTY		
9	SHARE; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.		
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11	WHEREAS, public works projects and studies relating to beach erosion control,		
12	beach preservation, marine environmental protection, beach management, and hurricane		
13	protection are eligible for State of Florida ("State") funding consideration under the		
14	provisions of Chapter 161, Florida Statutes;		
15	WHEREAS, in order to qualify for State beach management funding, current State		
16	policy requires submission of a long-range local government funding request that		
17	specifies projects relating to management of beaches or inlets;		
18	WHEREAS, inlet sand bypassing and beach erosion control projects using		
19	compatible materials, including nearshore, offshore, and upland sand, have been, and		
20	are planned to be, conducted by Broward County as local project sponsor, with		
21	subsequent reimbursement of the federal and State shares of eligible costs; and		
22	WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Broward County ("Board") has		
23	determined that it is in the best interest of the citizens of Broward County to pursue all		
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available funding in order to restore and maintain the inlets and beaches of Broward
 County, NOW, THEREFORE,

4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF 5 BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

7 Section 1. The Board authorizes and directs the Environmental Protection and
8 Growth Management Department to file a long-range local government funding request
9 with the Florida Department of Environmental Protection pursuant to the Beach
10 Management Funding Assistance Program for Fiscal Year 2021-2022.

Section 2. The Board supports the design and permitting of Segment III
Broward County Shore Protection Project beach renourishment and Segment II
Construction of Mitigation Reef (collectively, "Projects") for which funding is requested
from the State of Florida.

Section 3. Broward County intends and is able to serve as the local sponsor for
the Projects and intends and is able to provide the appropriate local funding share from
beach capital funds to implement the Projects.

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Section 4. <u>Severability</u>.

If any portion of this Resolution is determined by any court to be invalid, the invalid
portion will be stricken, and such striking will not affect the validity of the remainder of this
Resolution. If any court determines that this Resolution, in whole or in part, cannot be
legally applied to any individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance, such
determination will not affect the applicability of this Resolution to any other individual,
group, entity, property, or circumstance.
