

## RESOLUTION NO. 2021-

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF THE TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT TO SIGN AND SUBMIT AN APPLICATION FOR FEDERAL ASSISTANCE FOR FEDERAL FISCAL YEAR 2021 WITH THE FEDERAL TRANSIT ADMINISTRATION (FTA) PURSUANT TO 49 U.S.C. SECTION 5307, FOR CORONAVIRUS RESPONSE AND RELIEF SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS ACT URBANIZED AREA FORMULA FUNDS, IN THE AMOUNT OF THIRTY-SIX MILLION SEVEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED THIRTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$36,733,835); AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF THE TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT TO FURNISH THE FTA WITH ANY ADDITIONAL INFORMATION THAT MAY BE REQUIRED; AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO ACCEPT AN AWARD AND TO SIGN ANY AND ALL DOCUMENTATION THAT MAY BE REQUIRED IN CONNECTION WITH THE GRANT APPLICATION OR AWARD, SUBJECT TO REVIEW AND APPROVAL FOR LEGAL SUFFICIENCY BY THE OFFICE OF THE COUNTY ATTORNEY; AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO TAKE ALL ADMINISTRATIVE AND BUDGETARY ACTIONS NECESSARY TO IMPLEMENT THE GRANT; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Secretary of the U.S. Department of Transportation is authorized to make grants for transit projects; and

WHEREAS, the Federal Transit Administration allocated Twenty-five Billion Dollars in Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act (CRRSAA) funds to help public transportation systems respond to Coronavirus Disease 2019, NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The Director of the Transportation Department is authorized to sign and submit a grant application with the U.S. Department of Transportation pursuant to 49 U.S.C. Section 5307 of the Federal Transit Act for Fiscal Year 2021 CRRSAA Urbanized

1 Area Formula Funds, in the amount of Thirty-six Million Seven Hundred Thirty-three  
2 Thousand Eight Hundred Thirty-five Dollars (\$36,733,835), to help Broward County Transit  
3 respond to Coronavirus Disease 2019.

4 Section 2. The Director of the Transportation Department, or designee, is  
5 authorized to furnish all information that the U.S. Department of Transportation, Federal  
6 Transit Administration may require in connection with the application.

7 Section 3. The County Administrator is authorized to accept a grant award,  
8 unless this Resolution is specifically rescinded, and to sign any and all documentation that  
9 may be required in connection with the grant application, subject to review and approval for  
10 legal sufficiency by the Office of the County Attorney.

11 Section 4. The County Administrator is authorized to take all necessary  
12 administrative and budgetary actions to implement the grant.

13 Section 5. Effective Date.

14 This Resolution is effective upon adoption.
