The Broward County Sheriff's Office Department of Fire Rescue was awarded \$450,000 in the FY18 Port Security Grant Program (PSGP) in order to purchase a new supply of 1%^x3% firefighting foam for the purpose of petroleum and marine firefighting in the Seaport. We are requesting Port Everglades approval to provide funds to cover the 25% Cost Share in the amount of \$112,500.

The acquisition of 1%^x3% AR-AFFF is necessary to modernize the current technology of foam on hand. This investments in foam modernization will allow for less foam concentrate to be used for the suppression of a petroleum fire. The benefit of 1%^x3% foam concentrate is the reduction in the total gallons of foam concentrate needed to suppress a petroleum fire and is more environmentally responsible.

BSO Fire Rescue at Port Everglades is requesting a transfer of \$112,500 which is the agreed upon grant match, from Port Everglades to the Broward Sheriffs Officer Department of Fire Rescue. This project would then proceed through our purchasing department.
