8	WHEREAS, Section 341.052, Florida Statutes, created the public transit block
9	grant program administered by the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT);
10	WHEREAS, the public transit block grant program provides funding to public transit
11	providers to assist with operating costs for the provision of public transit services;
12	WHEREAS, Broward County is a recipient of public transit block grant funds;
13	WHEREAS, on December 8, 2020 (Item No. 12), the Broward County Board of
14	County Commissioners approved Resolution No. 2020-718 adopting the Broward County
15	Transit Development Plan 2021-2030 Annual Update;
16	WHEREAS, based upon the Broward County Transit Development Plan
17	2021-2030 Annual Update, FDOT approved Ten Million Six Hundred Ninety-three
18	Thousand Four Hundred Thirty Dollars (\$10,693,430) in Fiscal Year 2022 public transit
19	block grant funds for Broward County Transportation Department operating expenses;

21	WHEREAS, the Public Transportation Grant Agreement must be approved by the
22	transit agency's governing body, NOW, THEREFORE,

4	Section 1. The Board of County Commissioners of Broward County, Florida (the
5	"Board"), authorizes its Mayor to execute the Public Transportation Grant Agreement
6	(PTGA) with FDOT, District 4, attached as Exhibit 1, in the amount of Ten Million Six
7	Hundred Ninety-three Thousand Four Hundred Thirty Dollars (\$10,693,430), granted
8	under Financial Project No. 407186-3-84-01, to provide funding for public transportation
9	operating expenses for the project.
10	Section 2. The Board authorizes the County Administrator to take all necessary
11	administrative and budgetary actions to implement the PTGA.
12	Section 3. <u>Effective Date</u> .
