

Notice of Public Hearing and Intent to Consider
Vacating and Abandoning
Portions of Southwest 76 Avenue and Southwest 36 Street
(2018-V-22)

Notice is hereby given by the Board of County Commissioners, Broward County, Florida, that said Board will hold a Public Hearing at 10:00 A.M., Tuesday, October 6, 2020 in the Broward County Governmental Center, Room 422, 115 South Andrews Avenue, Fort Lauderdale, Florida, to vacate, abandon, discontinue, and close portions of Southwest 76 Avenue and Southwest 36 Street rights-of-way lying within Parcel B of Young World Plat, as recorded in Plat Book 124, Page 43; Parcel A of Nova University No. 1, as recorded in Plat Book 146, Page 49; Parcel D of Nova South, as recorded in Plat Book 182, Page 144; and Tract 68 of Everglades Land Sales Company's Subdivision, as recorded in Plat Book 2, Page 34, all of the Public Records of Broward County and located at 3301 College Avenue in the Town of Davie. The full legal description and complete text of the proposed release of easement is available for inspection at the Broward County Governmental Center, Planning and Development Management Division, 1 North University Drive, Room 102A, Plantation, Florida.

Interested parties may appear at the October 6, 2020 meeting and be heard with respect to the proposed release of easement. Public participation at the meeting shall be limited to telephonic participation only, pursuant to the Governor's Executive Order Number 20 69.
