(e) Owner shall mean a person who holds legal title to a vehicle, or in the event a
vehicle is the subject of an agreement for conditional sale or lease thereof with the right
of purchase upon performance of the conditions stated in the agreement and with an
immediate right of possession vested in the conditional vendee or lessee, or in the event
a mortgagor of a vehicle is entitled to possession, then such conditional vendee, lessee,
or mortgagor shall be deemed the owner for the purposes of this Article VI.

7 (f) *Park* or *parking* shall mean the standing of a vehicle, whether occupied or not,
8 other than temporarily for the purpose of and while actually engaged in loading or
9 unloading passengers, luggage, or cargo as may be permitted under this Article VI.

10 (g) Stopping or standing shall mean the halting of a vehicle, whether occupied or not,
11 other than temporarily for the purpose of and while actually engaged in loading or
12 unloading passengers, luggage, or cargo as may be permitted under this Article VI.

Section 2. Section 2-209 of the Broward County Code of Ordinances is hereby
amended to read as follows:

15 Sec. 2-209. Passenger loading zone; curbside parking.

(a) No person shall stop, stand, or park a vehicle for any purpose or period of
time except momentarily for the expeditious loading or unloading of passengers or
luggage in any place marked with an appropriate sign as a passenger <u>a</u> loading or
unloading zone.

(b) Curbside parking is prohibited except for those vehicles engaged in active
 loading and or unloading of passengers or luggage. Curbside parking, loading, and
 unloading in zones designated for taxicabs or other ground transportation services
 (Ground Transportation Area) is are prohibited for all vehicles other than taxicabs or

ground transportation services unless specifically authorized by the Aviation
 Department.

3 Section 3. Section 2-210 of the Broward County Code of Ordinances is hereby
4 amended to read as follows:

5 Sec. 2-210. Parking for disabled persons.

6 It is unlawful for any person to stop, stand, or park a vehicle within any parking 7 space designated and marked for disabled parking in accordance with § 316.1955, F.S. 8 unless such vehicle displays a parking permit issued pursuant to § Sections 316.1958 or 9 320.0848, F.S. Florida Statutes, or a license plate issued pursuant to § Sections 320.084, 10 320.0842, <del>F.S., § 320.084, F.S.,</del> 320.0843, or § 320.0845, <del>F.S.</del> Florida Statutes, as such 11 statutes may be amended from time to time, and such vehicle is transporting a person 12 eligible for such parking privileges; however, any person who is chauffeuring a disabled 13 person shall be allowed, without need for an identification parking permit or license plate, 14 momentary parking in any such parking space for the purpose of loading or unloading 15 such disabled person, and no penalty shall be imposed upon the driver for such 16 momentary parking.

17 Section 4. Section 2-214 of the Broward County Code of Ordinances is hereby18 amended to read as follows:

19 Sec. 2-214. Citations of illegally parked vehicles.

Whenever any vehicle, with or without a driver, is found to be parked, standing, or stopped in violation of any of the provisions of this Article VI, an enforcement officer shall <u>document the violation by photograph or video and</u> conspicuously affix to such vehicle a written citation, as hereinafter defined, on an appropriate form. <u>The photograph or video</u> <u>shall be made available to the driver, operator, or hearing officer upon request, and shall</u>
