Re: Adjusting Navigation Improvements Project

Dear Mr. Anderton:

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) has received notice that Broward County has approved a Project Partnership Agreement (PPA) with the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers to move forward on next steps of the Port Everglades Navigation Improvements Project. Now that the Project schedule has been updated, the Department recommends adjusting state funding to align more closely with the timing of possible expenditures. This included table outlines current and recommended contracting actions, which are further described below.

• **G0L27:** This contract has a 5-year performance period expiring 12/31/2022, and a 03/03/2021 balance of \$51,388,637. It is recommended that this agreement be closed, using the attached Joint Participation Agreement (JPA) Termination form. The respective funds will be placed on new contracts in state fiscal years 2021 (\$43,188,637) and 2023 (\$8,200,000). Placing a portion (\$8,200,000) of these funds in fiscal year 2023 will establish a new performance period for these funds which aligns more closely with the timing of possible expenditures and will also free up state funds in the near term for use by FDOT on shovel ready projects.

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- **G1761:** The attached Public Transportation Grant Agreement (PTGA) Amendment replaces project language to describe the scope of the project more fully. This contract will remain intact and become the primary contract for invoicing FDOT until funds have been exhausted.
- New FY 2021 Contract: The attached Public Transportation Grant Agreement (PTGA) establishes a new 5-year performance period for fiscal year 2021 funds in the amount of \$43,188,637.
- New FY 2023 Contract: Balance of funds remaining from contract G0L27 (\$8,200,000) will be added to the Department's work program item 433414-1. Subject to fiscal year 2023 legislative appropriations, a new contract will be available for execution after July 1, 2022.
