WHEREAS, the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization ("MPO") has funds under its Complete Streets and Local Initiatives Program to construct bicycle lanes and sidewalks along NW 21st Avenue from Oakland Park Boulevard to NW 26th Street ("Project") within the City of Oakland Park ("City");

WHEREAS, the right-of-way within the Project's limits is functionally classified as a Broward County ("County") road;

WHEREAS, the City has collaborated with the County's Highway Construction and Engineering Division, the MPO, and the Florida Department of Transportation ("FDOT") to develop the Project;

WHEREAS, the MPO requires a resolution from the County supporting the Project;

WHEREAS, FDOT requires a resolution from the County recognizing its role as the agency responsible for the design, construction, and construction administration of the Project;

WHEREAS, the Project will further the County's Complete Streets efforts while furthering the County's goal to "support the development, design and construction of sustainable, multi-modal transportation facilities throughout the County, to meet the demands of residents, travelers, and businesses";

WHEREAS, FDOT will be the agency responsible for design, construction, and construction administration of the Project; and

WHEREAS, FDOT's design, construction, and construction administration for the Project must meet or exceed the "Minimum Standards Applicable to Public Rights-of-Way under Broward County Jurisdiction," Section 25.1, Exhibit 25.A, of the Broward County Administrative Code, NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

- Section 1. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are affirmed as true and correct and adopted as part of this Resolution.
- Section 2. The Board of County Commissioners of Broward County, Florida ("Board"), supports the Project which will improve conditions for bicyclists and pedestrians along NW 21st Avenue from Oakland Park Boulevard to NW 26th Street within the City.
- Section 3. The Board recognizes FDOT as the agency responsible for the Project's design, construction, and construction administration.
 - Section 4. Severability.
