3 A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY  
4 COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA,  
5 PERTAINING TO RATES, FEES, AND CHARGES AT FORT  
6 LAUDERDALE-HOLLYWOOD INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT;  
7 AMENDING SECTION 39.2 AND EXHIBIT 39.A OF THE  
8 BROWARD COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE CODE  
9 ("ADMINISTRATIVE CODE"), TO REFLECT CHANGES TO  
10 RATES, FEES, AND CHARGES; AND PROVIDING FOR  
11 SEVERABILITY, INCLUSION IN THE ADMINISTRATIVE  
12 CODE, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

13 WHEREAS, as required by Section 2-3 of the Broward County Code of  
14 Ordinances, the Broward County Board of County Commissioners ("Board") fixes and  
15 establishes, through the adoption of a resolution, the rates, fees, and charges for the  
16 services and facilities provided at Broward County's Fort Lauderdale-Hollywood  
17 International Airport;

18 WHEREAS, the rates, fees, and charges established by resolution are included in  
19 Chapter 39 of the Broward County Administrative Code; and

20 WHEREAS, the Board desires to amend certain provisions of Chapter 39 in order  
21 to revise the schedule of rates, fees, and charges, NOW, THEREFORE,

22 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF  
23 BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

24 Section 1. Section 39.2 of the Broward County Administrative Code is hereby  
amended to read as follows:

**39.2. Rates, Fees, and Charges—Fort Lauderdale-Hollywood International  
Airport.**

1 a. Terminal Rates and Charges:

3 (a) Type 1 Space, per square foot, per annum: ~~\$179.00~~ 217.70

4 (b) Type 2 Space, per square foot, per annum: ~~\$166.47~~ 202.46

5 (c) Type 3 Space, per square foot, per annum: ~~\$128.88~~ 156.74

6 (d) Type 4 Space, per square foot, per annum: \$1.00

7 2. All Others:

8 (a) Type 1 Space, per square foot, per annum: ~~\$232.70~~ 283.01

9 (b) Type 2 Space, per square foot, per annum: ~~\$216.41~~ 263.20

10 (c) Type 3 Space, per square foot, per annum: ~~\$167.55~~ 203.76

13 1. Signatory Airlines:

14 (a) Rate of ~~one dollar and forty-one cents (\$1.41)~~ two dollars and  
15 sixteen cents (\$2.16) per one thousand (1,000) pounds of  
16 nominal gross landed weight, as determined by the Aviation  
17 Department, for each revenue arrival. (A revenue arrival is a  
18 plane that arrives at the airport which generates business from  
19 that arrival or departure from the airport.)

21 2. Non-Wholly Owned Affiliated Airlines:

22 (a) Rate of ~~one dollar and seventy cents (\$1.70)~~ two dollars and sixty  
23 cents (\$2.60) per one thousand (1,000) pounds of nominal gross  
24 landed weight, as determined by the Aviation Department, for

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each revenue arrival. (A revenue arrival is a plane that arrives at the airport which generates business from that arrival or departure from the airport.)

3. All Others:

(a) Rate of ~~one dollar and eighty four cents (\$1.84)~~ two dollars and eighty-one cents (\$2.81) per one thousand (1,000) pounds of nominal gross landed weight, as determined by the Aviation Department, for each revenue and non-revenue arrival by a plane.

Section 2. Exhibit 39.A of the Broward County Administrative Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

11 (5) All passenger check-in facilities must be reserved in advance, with the approval of  
12 the Aviation Department. Passenger check-in facilities charges shall be applied at  
13 the rate of ~~twenty-one dollars (\$21.00)~~ thirty-six dollars (\$36.00) per hour, or any  
14 part thereof, for Signatory Carriers, and ~~twenty-seven dollars (\$27.00)~~ forty-seven  
15 dollars (\$47.00) per hour, or any part thereof, for all other carriers, per ticket  
16 counter position for any passenger check-in facility reserved, whether utilized or  
17 not. Signatory Carriers will not be charged, on a monthly basis, for per use  
18 passenger check-in facilities in an amount greater than would otherwise be  
19 charged to that carrier for a monthly preferential lease of equivalent ticket counter  
20 space.

22 (8) Signatory Carriers using a per use gate shall not be charged more than the

9 Section 3. Severability.

10 If any portion of this Administrative Code Resolution is determined by any court to  
11 be invalid, the invalid portion will be stricken, and such striking will not affect the validity  
12 of the remainder of this Administrative Code Resolution. If any court determines that this  
13 Administrative Code Resolution, in whole or in part, cannot be legally applied to any  
14 individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance, such determination will not affect the  
15 applicability of this Administrative Code Resolution to any other individual, group, entity,  
16 property, or circumstance.

17 Section 4. Inclusion in the Broward County Administrative Code.

18 It is the intention of the Board of County Commissioners that the provisions of this  
19 Administrative Code Resolution become part of the Broward County Administrative Code  
20 as of the effective date. The sections of this Administrative Code Resolution may be  
21 renumbered or relettered and the word "resolution" may be changed to "section," "article,"  
22 or such other appropriate word or phrase to the extent necessary in order to accomplish  
23 such intention.

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Section 5. Effective Date.

This Administrative Code Resolution is effective on October 1, 2020.
