I. REQUEST: Provide a description of the features of the product/service or Scope of Work.

Florida Chapter 252 declares that the Florida Division of Emergency Management (FDEM) maintain a comprehensive statewide program, which includes a web-based tool to facilitate statewide emergency management functions. The State has selected ESi Acquisition to provide the WebEOC software platform, maintenance and professional services. The platform allows the State Emergency Response Team (SERT) to use the same operating environment when preparing for, responding to, and recovering from an emergency. Requests for assistance are made through the platform; these requests are approved, tasked as missions, and tracked throughout their life cycle. Information messages like situation reports, press releases, and incident action plans may also be shared through the platform. Having this information all in one place allows for effective response to and recovery from emergencies while documenting events for reimbursement and after-action reporting.

ESi Acquisition's WebEOC Software is used to support the SERT during Emergency Operations Center activations/day-to-day operations and is the established system to provide key mission support and information sharing across the SERT in providing emergency planning, response, recovery and mitigation activities during a disaster or event.

Professional; WebEOC® for Hospitals; WebEOC® Fusion; WebEOC® Town Square; WebEOC® Core; and, WebEOC Resource Request and Deployment Module.

As the only entity with access to the WebEOC source code, ESi is the only entity which may accurately diagnosis software errors and defects, issue corrections and fully integrated enhancements, and warrant performance of the software.

As the only entity with access to the ESi WebEOC Software source code, ESi is the only entity which may accurately diagnose software errors and defects, issue corrections and fully integrated enhancements, and warrant performance of the ESi WebEOC Software. ESi also provides a wide range of professional services. These services are specialized in nature and focused on configuration and technical support for the proprietary software technology. These services frequently require access to ESi proprietary information and are not available through or resold by any third parties. The WebEOC Software Core Subscription services and supporting Emergency Management and Municipal Operations Modules also are available exclusively from ESi.

Sole source acquisition of the ESi WebEOC Software products and services may be justified under Subpart 6.3 of the Federal Acquisition Regulations ("FAR"). In the case of software products and software maintenance, the FAR allow sole source acquisition of unique items which are available from one or a limited number of sources or for proprietary items where only limited data rights are provided under license. The ESi WebEOC Software meets these requirements. State and local government organizations are encouraged to ask their procurement officer if local laws include similar sole source provisions, or if the federal justifications may be used to support sole source procurement.
