1 **RESOLUTION NO.** 2 A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD 3 COUNTY, FLORIDA, ACCEPTING A DONATION FROM BROWARD PUBLIC LIBRARY 4 FOUNDATION, INC., OF TOUCHSCREEN TABLETS, KEYBOARDS, AND INTERNET 5 DATA PLANS, VALUED AT \$114,414.98, FOR THE WORKFORCE READY INITIATIVE; 6 AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO TAKE ANY NECESSARY 7 ADMINISTRATIVE AND BUDGETARY ACTIONS: AND PROVIDING FOR 8 SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE. 9 10 WHEREAS, Broward Public Library Foundation, Inc. ("Foundation") has most 11 generously offered to donate touchscreen tablets, keyboards, and internet data plans to 12 the Libraries Division, with a total value of One Hundred Fourteen Thousand Four 13 Hundred Fourteen and 98/100 Dollars (\$114,414.98), for the Library Division's Workforce 14 Ready Initiative; 15 WHEREAS, Section 18.63 of the Broward County Administrative Code requires 16 that donations to Broward County valued at Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000) or more 17 must be accepted by a resolution of the Board of County Commissioners ("Board"); and 18 WHEREAS, the Board wishes to accept the generous donation and express its 19 gratitude for such donation, NOW, THEREFORE, 20 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF 21 BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The Board hereby accepts the donation of touchscreen tablets,
keyboards, and internet data plans, with a total value of One Hundred Fourteen Thousand
Four Hundred Fourteen and 98/100 Dollars (\$114,414.98), from Broward Public Library
Foundation, Inc., located at 100 S. Andrews Avenue, Fort Lauderdale, Florida 33301.

Section 2. The donated items will be used for the Library Division's WorkforceReady Initiative.

28 Section 3. The County Administrator is hereby authorized to take all 29 administrative and budgetary actions and execute all forms required to accept the 30 donation in accordance with the purposes stated in this Resolution.
