B. A waiver of conflict arising under Section 112.313(7)(a), Florida Statutes, requires two-thirds approval by the Board in accordance with Section 112.313(12), Florida Statutes. What Action Accomplishes: Appoints Cindy W. Baldwin to the Library Advisory Board. Is this Action Commission Goal Related?
