6	ACTIONS TO EFFECTUATE THE RENAMING OF THE COUNTY ROAD; DIRECTING THE COUNTY
7	ADMINISTRATOR TO PROVIDE A COPY OF THIS RESOLUTION TO THE OFFICIALS DESIGNATED HEREIN;

11	WHEREAS, Section 18.43 of the Broward County Administrative Code
12	("Administrative Code") sets out the policy of the Board of County Commissioners
13	("Board") for naming property owned by Broward County ("County");
14	
15	WHEREAS, Congressman Alcee L. Hastings ("Congressman Hastings") is a
16	person who made numerous significant contributions to the County, including as a civil
17	rights leader;

19	WHEREAS, Congressman Hastings sadly passed away on April 6, 2021, after a
20	life dedicated to public service;

22	WHEREAS, that portion of NW 8th Street from NW 27th Avenue to NW 31st
23	Avenue is a County-owned road located in the Broward Municipal Services District
24	("County Road");

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 336.05, Florida Statutes, the Board of County Commissioners ("Board") is authorized to name and rename County-owned streets and roads:

WHEREAS, Section 18.43 of the Broward County Administrative Code ("Administrative Code") establishes the policy of the Board for naming property, buildings, structures, or facilities, including roads;

WHEREAS, on May 4, 2021 (Board Agenda Item No. 51), the Board (1) provided notice on the record that the Board would consider the proposed designation of the County Road in honor of Congressman Hastings on June 15, 2021, as required by Section 18.43(h) of the Administrative Code; (2) waived Section 18.43(d) of the Administrative Code, which provides that property owned by the County may be renamed after persons who have passed away following a minimum 90-day waiting period in order to consider renaming the County Road after Congressman Hastings; and (3) directed the County Administrator to solicit the input of at least three local municipalities, homeowners' associations, or community groups of the Board's proposed renaming of the County Road, which correspondence is attached hereto as Attachment 1; and

WHEREAS, in recognition of the contributions of Congressman Hastings, the Board desires to designate the County Road as "Alcee Street" in honor of Congressman Hastings, NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The Board hereby renames the County Road as "Alcee Street" in honor of Congressman Hastings. In accordance with Section 18.43(g) of the Administrative Code, the current name of the County Road shall be retained as a secondary designation.

Section 2. The Board directs the County Administrator, as Clerk of the Board, to transmit a copy of this Resolution to the United States Postal Service, the Broward County Highway Construction and Engineering Division, the Broward County Sheriff's Office, and the Broward County Sheriff's Office Department of Fire Rescue.

Section 3. The Board further directs the County Administrator to take all budgetary and other actions necessary to effectuate the renaming of the County Road as "Alcee Street."

#### Section 4. Severability.

If any portion of this Resolution is determined by any court to be invalid, the invalid portion will be stricken, and such striking will not affect the validity of the remainder of this Resolution. If any court determines that this Resolution, in whole or in part, cannot be legally applied to any individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance, such determination will not affect the applicability of this Resolution to any other individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance.

# Broward County Transit (BCT) will resume collecting bus fares on Tuesday, June 1, 2021

Passengers will be asked to board through the front door, pay their fares and exit through the rear doors. Passengers are also required to wear face masks and maintain a safe social distance when riding the bus.

BCT will continue its policy to maintain social distancing and increase frequency on bus routes when needed. Additional enhanced safety measures include disinfecting buses nightly with extra cleaning during the day, equipping buses with ionizing air purifiers that clean the air, and installing bus operator cabin partitions throughout the entire fleet.

Beginning May 24<sup>th</sup>, paper bus passes can be purchased online at <u>Broward.org/BCT</u> or inperson at BCT terminals, County libraries and participating businesses. Also available May 24<sup>th</sup>, BCT's **Mobile ticketing app**. Mobile tickets are a safe, easy and convenient way to purchase bus fare. Customers can download the <u>Broward County Transit Mobile Ticketing app</u> to their smartphone from Google Play or the Apple App Store, buy their ticket and scan it when boarding.






