10	WHEREAS, many construction employers are having difficulty filling skilled trade
11	positions due to the shortage of qualified candidates;
12	WHEREAS, the shortage of qualified candidates for skilled trade positions could
13	result in delays, increased expenses, and other impediments to future County
14	construction projects;
15	WHEREAS, participation in an apprenticeship program will create opportunities for
16	training and experience in skilled trade positions, which in turn will assist in ensuring that
17	a trained workforce will be available in the future for County construction projects;
18	WHEREAS, the commencement of the Broward County Construction
19	Apprenticeship Program ("Apprenticeship Program") was deferred in light of the current
20	Local State of Emergency regarding COVID-19; and
21	WHEREAS, the Broward County Board of County Commissioners (the "Board")
22	now desires to set a date certain for the commencement of the Apprenticeship Program,

1	BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
2	BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

4	Section 1. Section 26-8 of the Broward County Code of Ordinances is hereby
5	amended to read as follows:
6	Sec. 26-8. Apprentices for county construction contracts.

8	(c) Effective Date. The Apprenticeship Program shall be effective to all new
9	County construction contracts solicited on or after April 5, 2021.

11	Section 2. <u>Severability</u> .
12	If any portion of this Ordinance is determined by any court to be invalid, the invalid
13	portion will be stricken, and such striking will not affect the validity of the remainder of this
14	Ordinance. If any court determines that this Ordinance, in whole or in part, cannot be
15	legally applied to any individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance, such
16	determination will not affect the applicability of this Ordinance to any other individual,
17	group, entity, property, or circumstance.
