Item 20-1802, a police and criminal justice review board is before you for consideration tomorrow. As drafted this review board will apply to municipal police departments, independent of the Broward Sheriff's Office. To my knowledge, not one municipality has been consulted on this item. As such, I urge each of you to table discussion of the item until such time as the review board concept can be properly vetted with the Broward County cities that have independent police agencies and will be directly impacted by this item. Input from all stakeholders is critical.

If such a board is established, at sometime following a full vetting with the municipalities, it should be exclude organizations that have limited knowledge of police procedure. Involving organizations with limited knowledge of police procedure will only serve to politicize the board. The board being proposed should include many unbiased law enforcement personnel with extensive knowledge of proper police procedures.

I **strongly request** that this item be tabled for the foreseeable future so that the municipalities with independent police departments can properly participate and not be excluded from the decision making process.
