SCOPE OF SERVICES**

SECTION I: PURPOSE

The purpose of this Scope of Services is to describe the professional services required by the Broward County ("County") in connection with work activities which are a part of the total services to be provided under RS&H, Inc.'s ("Consultant") October 23, 2018 Continuing Engineering Services for Transportation and General Civil Engineering Project ("Project") Agreement ("Agreement") with the County.

The Project limits for this Work Authorization will be the County limits as well as any areas outside of the County that require consideration in order to appropriately complete a required task.

The Consultant shall demonstrate effective and efficient project management practices while working on this Work Authorization. This includes regular communication with the County and others as necessary, thorough management of time and resources, and complete documentation.

The County will provide contract administration, management services, and technical reviews of all work associated with the development and preparation of the task work products. The County will provide job specific information as outlined in the Agreement.

SECTION II: CONTRACT MANAGEMENT

The County Contract Administrator and Project Manager will ensure the fulfillment and enforcement of the Agreement terms and receipt of a quality work product. The County Contract Administrator will be responsible for enforcing the terms of the Agreement and approving all invoices. The County Project Manager will serve as the primary day-to-day point of contact with the Consultant for matters relative to the Agreement and will review all Agreement invoices prior to payment. The County Project Manager will be responsible for the approval of activities related to the Agreement and will serve as the liaison between the Consultant and the County.

During the term of the Agreement, the County will conduct reviews of the various phases of the Consultant's operations. The Consultant will cooperate and assist the County representatives in conducting these reviews. The County Project Manager will be responsible for reviews of the Consultant's work.

The Consultant shall be responsible for the professional quality, technical accuracy, and systematic coordination of all work products and other services furnished by the Consultant under this Agreement.

The Consultant's work shall be performed and directed by key personnel identified by the Consultant and approved by the County. Any changes in the indicated personnel shall be subject to review and approval by the County Contract Administrator or their designated representative.

SECTION III: TASK SERVICES

1. Scope of Services

The services performed by the Consultant shall follow all applicable federal; state; and County laws, policies, regulations, standards, manuals, and guidelines.

The County is requesting that the Consultant provide professional services for miscellaneous roadway projects for Surtax improvement and maintenance projects for the designated Time for Performance, as identified in this Article's Subsection 3. The services will include engineering design and analysis, plans and specifications preparation, cost estimating, technical documents development and review, field reviews and site visits, construction inspection, and other miscellaneous services as assigned, paid on a Maximum Amount Not-To-Exceed bases as identified in this Work Authorization.

The Consultant is expected to augment and support County staff with construction inspections, design of roadway and bridge repairs, and related projects. Consultant will report to the Highway and Bridge Maintenance Division Office in Pompano Beach or another location as agreed upon for the duration of this Work Authorization. The County will supply a workstation for Consultant while working at the County facility. For all remote work, the Consultant will provide computer, electronics, equipment, and software necessary to complete work associated with this Work Authorization at no cost to the County, unless otherwise approved by the County. Remote work will only be permitted with prior approval from the County. During remote work, Consultant shall be continuously and immediately available during all billable hours.
