## **RESOLUTION NO.**

1	A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD
2	COUNTY, FLORIDA, IN SUPPORT OF LEGISLATION REQUIRING THAT ANY USE OF
3	HANDHELD MOBILE DEVICES WHILE DRIVING BE HANDS-FREE; DIRECTING THE
4	COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO TRANSMIT COPIES OF THIS RESOLUTION TO
5	DESIGNATED PERSONS; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND AN
6	EFFECTIVE DATE.

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9	WHEREAS, distracted driving is a leading cause of motor vehicle crashes in the
10	United States, contributing to thousands of injuries and fatalities each year;
11	WHEREAS, a study from Cambridge Mobile Telematics reported an increase in
12	screen interaction time while driving of 17.8% from 2020 to 2023;
13	WHEREAS, the handheld use of mobile devices while driving impairs a driver's
14	ability to safely operate a vehicle, diverting attention from the road and increasing reaction
15	times;
16	WHEREAS, Broward County has witnessed too many traffic crashes attributed to
17	distracted driving, affecting the safety of men, women, and children who reside in or visit
18	the county;
19	WHEREAS, implementing legislation banning handheld use of mobile devices
20	while driving use can reduce the incidence of distracted driving, saving lives and
21	promoting safer roadways for all;

WHEREAS, more than 30 states have enacted hands-free laws, resulting in a
 measurable decrease in fatalities related to distracted driving;

WHEREAS, Florida law currently prohibits texting while driving, but the statutory
prohibition against handheld use of mobile devices is currently limited to school zones,
designated school crossings, and active construction work zones; and

WHEREAS, it is the responsibility of the local government to advocate for the
safety and well-being of the community, NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The Board of County Commissioners of Broward County, Florida
("Board"), hereby expresses its strong support for legislation mandating that any use of
handheld mobile devices while driving be hands-free.

34 Section 2. The Board urges the Florida Legislature to pass such legislation to
35 enhance road safety and protect lives.

36 Section 3. The Board hereby directs that the County Administrator transmit a 37 copy of this Resolution to Governor Ron DeSantis, to all Florida state legislators 38 representing Broward County residents, and to such other local advocacy groups as the 39 County Administrator deems advisable to demonstrate the Board's commitment to 40 reducing distracted driving and improving the safety of our roadways.

41 Section 4. Severability.

If any portion of this Resolution is determined by any court to be invalid, the invalid
portion will be stricken, and such striking will not affect the validity of the remainder of this
Resolution. If any court determines that this Resolution, in whole or in part, cannot be

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45	legally applied to any individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance, such
46	determination will not affect the applicability of this Resolution to any other individual,
47	group, entity, property, or circumstance.
48	Section 5. Effective Date.
