

RESOLUTION NO.

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, PERTAINING TO WATER AND WASTEWATER SERVICES; AMENDING SECTION 38.18 OF THE BROWARD COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE CODE ("ADMINISTRATIVE CODE") TO PRESCRIBE A REVISED SCHEDULE OF WATER AND WASTEWATER SERVICE RATES, FEES, AND CHARGES; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, INCLUSION IN THE ADMINISTRATIVE CODE, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Broward County has the right to regulate the use of sewers and the supply of water within Broward County and to establish and collect rates, fees, and charges for usage of Broward County's water and wastewater facilities;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 34-6 of the Broward County Code of Ordinances, the water and wastewater rates, fees, and charges are required to be established following public notice and a public hearing, which, in this matter, have been satisfied; and;

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners finds it is reasonable and in the best interest of the public to revise Section 38.18 of the Broward County Administrative Code to reflect the new rates, fees, and charges for water and wastewater services, effective with all services rendered on or after October 1, 2022, NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The recitals set forth in the preamble to this Resolution are incorporated by reference herein.

Section 2. Section 38.18 of the Broward County Administrative Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

38.18. Water and Wastewater Services Rates, Fees, and Charges.

The following schedule of rates, fees, and charges for water and wastewater services to be rendered by Broward County Water and Wastewater Services (WWS) is effective with all services rendered on or after October 1, ~~2021~~ 2022:

158 Administrative Code Resolution become part of the Broward County Administrative Code
159 as of the effective date. The sections of this Administrative Code Resolution may be
160 renumbered or relettered and the word "resolution" may be changed to "section," "article,"
161 or such other appropriate word or phrase to the extent necessary in order to accomplish
162 such intention.

This Administrative Code Resolution is effective upon adoption.
