1 **27.173. Implementation.**

2 (a) Contracts and other authorizations for temporary vendors on County
3 property or for the provision of goods or services to the County shall include a provision
4 that expanded polystyrene products (including, but not limited to, expanded polystyrene
5 food service articles), single-use plastic beverage straws, and single-use plastic stirrers
6 may not be sold or distributed on County property.

7 (b) The County may terminate any contract or other authorization for
8 noncompliance with this Part and may use past noncompliance as grounds for not
9 renewing or extending a contract or other authorization. Where applicable under the terms
10 of a contract or other authorization, the County may pursue appropriate contractual
11 remedies for noncompliance with this policy, including termination and/or preclusion or
12 debarment from future County contracts.

13 (c) This Part applies only to new the following: (i) contracts solicited resulting
14 from competitive solicitations that commenced on or entered into after June 1, 2022. This
15 policy applies to; (ii) contracts entered into on or after October 1, 2022, that were not the
16 result of a competitive solicitation; and (iii) any contracts renewed, extended, or amended
17 after June 1, 2023.

18 (d) The use of reusable materials on County property is strongly encouraged.

19 **27.174. Exemptions.**

20 The following shall be exempt from application and implementation of this Part:

21 (a) Expanded polystyrene food service articles, used for prepackaged food,
22 that have been filled and sealed prior to receipt by the food service provider.
