**27.173. Implementation.**

(a) Contracts and other authorizations for temporary vendors on County property or for the provision of goods or services to the County shall include a provision that expanded polystyrene products (including, but not limited to, expanded polystyrene food service articles), single-use plastic beverage straws, and single-use plastic stirrers may not be sold or distributed on County property.

(b) The County may terminate any contract or other authorization for noncompliance with this Part and may use past noncompliance as grounds for not renewing or extending a contract or other authorization. Where applicable under the terms of a contract or other authorization, the County may pursue appropriate contractual remedies for noncompliance with this policy, including termination and/or preclusion or debarment from future County contracts.

(c) This Part applies only to ~~new~~ the following: (i) contracts solicited resulting from competitive solicitations that commenced on or entered into after June 1, 2022. This policy applies to; (ii) contracts entered into on or after October 1, 2022, that were not the result of a competitive solicitation; and (iii) any contracts renewed, extended, or amended after June 1, 2023.

(d) The use of reusable materials on County property is strongly encouraged.

**27.174. Exemptions.**

The following shall be exempt from application and implementation of this Part:

(a) Expanded polystyrene food service articles, used for prepackaged food, that have been filled and sealed prior to receipt by the food service provider.
