A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, PERTAINING TO TAXIMETER RATES; AMENDING SECTION 40.50 OF THE BROWARD COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE CODE ("ADMINISTRATIVE CODE"); AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, INCLUSION IN THE ADMINISTRATIVE CODE, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, since October 2018, when taximeter rates last increased, the Consumer Price Index in South Florida has risen by thirty-five percent (35%) and gas prices have increased by twenty percent (20%):

WHEREAS, in a comparative analysis of taximeter rates across eighteen (18) jurisdictions, including Miami-Dade County and Palm Beach International Airport, seventy-nine percent (79%) exhibit higher rates than Broward County; and

WHEREAS, based on current market conditions, economic factors, data and analysis from the Consumer Protection Division, and industry stakeholder feedback, the Board of County Commissioners has determined there is a special necessity to review and adjust taximeter rates in Broward County, NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:
