RESOLUTION NO.

1 A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD
2 COUNTY, FLORIDA, ACCEPTING A DONATION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$100,000 FROM
3 THE ASHBRIITT FOUNDATION, INC., TO BE USED BY THE NANCY J. COTTERMAN
4 CENTER TO PURCHASE EQUIPMENT AND ESSENTIAL SUPPLIES TO ENHANCE
5 SERVICE DELIVERY TO SURVIVORS OF SEXUAL ASSAULT, CHILD ABUSE, AND
6 HUMAN TRAFFICKING; AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO TAKE
7 ALL ADMINISTRATIVE AND BUDGETARY ACTIONS REQUIRED TO IMPLEMENT
8 ACCEPTANCE AND UTILIZATION OF THE DONATION; AND PROVIDING FOR
9 SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

11 WHEREAS, the AshBritt Foundation, Inc., has generously offered to donate to the
12 Nancy J. Cotterman Center, the amount of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000)
13 to purchase equipment and essential supplies to enhance service delivery to survivors of
14 sexual assault, child abuse, and human trafficking;

15 WHEREAS, Section 18.63 of the Broward County Administrative Code requires
16 that donations to Broward County valued at ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) or more must
17 be accepted by a resolution of the Board of County Commissioners ("Board"), describing
18 the name and address of the donor, the amount of the donation, the specific purpose for
19 which the donation is made, any restriction on the use of the donation, and the account
20 into which the donation will be placed pending expenditure; and

21 WHEREAS, the Board wishes to accept the generous donation from the AshBritt
22 Foundation, Inc., and express its gratitude for the donation, NOW, THEREFORE,

23 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
24 BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

25 Section 1. The Board hereby accepts the donation in the amount of \$100,000
26 from the AshBritt Foundation, Inc., 565 East Hillsboro Boulevard, Deerfield Beach, Florida
27 33441. The donation will be deposited into the Nancy J. Cotterman Center Trust Fund
28 and used solely to purchase equipment and essential supplies to enhance service
29 delivery to survivors of sexual assault, child abuse, and human trafficking.

30 Section 2. The County Administrator is hereby authorized to take all
31 administrative and budgetary actions required to implement acceptance and utilization of
32 the donation.

33 Section 3. Severability.

34 If any portion of this Resolution is determined by any court to be invalid, the invalid
35 portion will be stricken, and such striking will not affect the validity of the remainder of this
36 Resolution. If any court determines that this Resolution, in whole or in part, cannot be
37 legally applied to any individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance, such
38 determination will not affect the applicability of this Resolution to any other individual,
39 group, entity, property, or circumstance.
