A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, ACCEPTING A DONATION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$100,000 FROM THE ASHBRITT FOUNDATION, INC., TO BE USED BY THE NANCY J. COTTERMAN CENTER TO PURCHASE EQUIPMENT AND ESSENTIAL SUPPLIES TO ENHANCE SERVICE DELIVERY TO SURVIVORS OF SEXUAL ASSAULT, CHILD ABUSE, AND HUMAN TRAFFICKING; AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO TAKE ALL ADMINISTRATIVE AND BUDGETARY ACTIONS REQUIRED TO IMPLEMENT ACCEPTANCE AND UTILIZATION OF THE DONATION; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the AshBritt Foundation, Inc., has generously offered to donate to the Nancy J. Cotterman Center, the amount of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000) to purchase equipment and essential supplies to enhance service delivery to survivors of sexual assault, child abuse, and human trafficking;

WHEREAS, Section 18.63 of the Broward County Administrative Code requires that donations to Broward County valued at ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) or more must be accepted by a resolution of the Board of County Commissioners ("Board"), describing the name and address of the donor, the amount of the donation, the specific purpose for which the donation is made, any restriction on the use of the donation, and the account into which the donation will be placed pending expenditure; and

WHEREAS, the Board wishes to accept the generous donation from the AshBritt Foundation, Inc., and express its gratitude for the donation, NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The Board hereby accepts the donation in the amount of \$100,000 from the AshBritt Foundation, Inc., 565 East Hillsboro Boulevard, Deerfield Beach, Florida 33441. The donation will be deposited into the Nancy J. Cotterman Center Trust Fund and used solely to purchase equipment and essential supplies to enhance service delivery to survivors of sexual assault, child abuse, and human trafficking.

Section 2. The County Administrator is hereby authorized to take all administrative and budgetary actions required to implement acceptance and utilization of the donation.

Section 3. Severability.

If any portion of this Resolution is determined by any court to be invalid, the invalid portion will be stricken, and such striking will not affect the validity of the remainder of this Resolution. If any court determines that this Resolution, in whole or in part, cannot be legally applied to any individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance, such determination will not affect the applicability of this Resolution to any other individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance.
