On September 27, 2011 (Item No. 62B), the Board approved the Signatory Terminal Building Lease Agreement (“Signatory TBLA”) between Broward County (“County”) and JetBlue Airways Corporation (“JetBlue”) commencing for a period of five years, expiring on September 30, 2016.

On June 4, 2013 (Item No. 88B), the Board approved the First Addendum to the Signatory TBLA with JetBlue, to manage the design, construction, and installation of an In-line Baggage System in Terminal 3 at Fort Lauderdale-Hollywood International Airport.

On October 28, 2014 (Item No. 6B), the Board approved the Fifth Amendment to the Signatory TBLA with JetBlue, which extended its term for ten years, expiring on September 30, 2026.

On June 15, 2021 (Item No. 128), the Board approved the Second Addendum between the County and JetBlue, for management of the Terminal 5 (“T5”) construction project, to be substantially complete within 890 calendar days after issuance of the third Notice to Proceed, in the not-to-exceed amount of \$306,000,000 and delegated authority to the County Administrator to execute. On July 21, 2021, the County Administrator executed an updated Second Addendum with modifications approved by the County Attorney’s Office resulting from a change in Florida Statutes 255.20, effective July 1, 2021, which impacted the use of County Programs on T5.
