- A. In my capacity as the County's archaeological consultant, based on the available information including archival documents, maps, the Broward County Land Use Plan and the Florida Master Site File (FMSF), it is my determination that the proposed project will have no adverse effect on any previously recorded resources, however, the proposed development may have an adverse effect on several previously unrecorded resources.
