Conference

We are requesting that a total of eight (8) Broward County Employees attend the 2025 Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) Petroleum Restoration Program (PRP) Annual Conference which has been scheduled for April 15-17, 2025, in Tallahassee, Florida. The Conference is held once a year and allows all FDEP PRP Site Managers and Remediation Specialists to interact with their counterparts from the two Staff Augmentation Contract Teams, six regional FDEP District offices, and all 12 contracted Local Programs. The objective of the meeting is to promote and maintain State-wide consistency throughout all facets of the petroleum cleanup program.

Broward County has 11 employees who currently work on petroleum cleanup under the PRP Contract. It is a contract requirement of the FDEP that 75 percent of the employees who work fully under the PRP contract attend these annual meetings in person. As such, the existing Contract with the State does account for travel expenses for employees to attend these annual meetings. The travel costs will therefore come directly from the FDEP Contract.

Costs for air travel, hotel accommodations, and meals are estimated in the amount of \$12,633.04. Attached is a summary of employees attending, estimated costs and chartfields.
