RESOLUTION NO.

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING A DONATION IN THE AMOUNT OF FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$5,000) TO THE DELTA EDUCATION AND LIFE DEVELOPMENT FOUNDATION, INC.; DIRECTING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO TAKE ALL ADMINISTRATIVE AND BUDGETARY ACTIONS NECESSARY TO IMPLEMENT THE DONATION; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Delta Education and Life Development Foundation, Inc. ("DELDF") is a nonprofit 501(c)(3), tax-exempt public service and community corporation with a mission to provide educational, charitable, and community services to the Broward County community;

WHEREAS, DELDF supports public service programs aimed at improving the quality of life of Broward County residents through education, cultural enrichment, and physical, emotional, and social well-being initiatives;

WHEREAS, annually, DELDF, in partnership with various community organizations, awards scholarships to qualified Broward County high school and college students to pursue higher education at institutions of their choice;

WHEREAS, in the past six years, DELDF, in support of its mission, has awarded over Three Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$300,000) in scholarships;

WHEREAS, numerous public and private individuals and entities have donated funds to Broward County ("County") designated to be donated by the County to a

scholarship fund in recognition of the retirement of former Broward County Administrator Bertha Henry;

WHEREAS, through Resolution No. 2022-082, the County previously donated Eighty-One Thousand Eight Hundred Ninety-Two Dollars (\$81,892) to DELDF in honor of Ms. Henry; and

WHEREAS, the Board desires to honor Ms. Henry and to support DELDF through an additional monetary donation, NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The Board finds that the donation to DELDF to support a scholarship fund in honor of Ms. Henry serves a public purpose and promotes public or community interest and welfare.

Section 2. The Board authorizes and approves the donation of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000) to DELDF in honor of Ms. Henry and to support DELDF's mission of improving the quality of life of Broward County residents through education, cultural enrichment, and physical, emotional, and social initiatives.

Section 3. The Board further directs the County Administrator to take all budgetary and other necessary actions to effectuate the donation to DELDF.

Section 4. Severability.

If any portion of this Resolution is determined by any court to be invalid, the invalid portion will be stricken, and such striking will not affect the validity of the remainder of this Resolution. If any court determines that this Resolution, in whole or in part, cannot be legally applied to any individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance, such

determination will not affect the applicability of this Resolution to any other individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance.

Section 5. Effective Date.

This Resolution is effective upon adoption.
