96 An Official Event is any event where:

- 97 a. The Elected Official has made an objective, good-faith
98 effort to determine that ~~A~~ at least thirty (30) persons not
99 affiliated with the donor have been invited to attend,
100 including multiple Elected Officials; and the Elected
101 Official attends the event in their official capacity; or
- 102 b. The Elected Official's governmental entity has officially
103 sponsored the event; or
- 104 c. The Elected Official was invited to the event in their
105 official capacity and the governmental entity's legal
106 counsel or chief budget officer has determined in
107 writing that attendance at the event serves a public
108 purpose.

109 For purposes of this Section 1-19(c)4, a person affiliated with
110 a donor means:

- 111 a. The donor's relative as defined in Section 112.3135,
112 Florida Statutes.
- 113 b. The donor's employee or employer; or
