A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD
 COUNTY, FLORIDA, REPEALING SECTIONS 22.175 THROUGH 22.177 OF THE
 BROWARD COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE CODE ("ADMINISTRATIVE CODE"),
 RELATING TO THE BROWARD COUNTY PROPERTY ASSESSED CLEAN ENERGY
 ("PACE") PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY,
 INCLUSION IN THE ADMINISTRATIVE CODE, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

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8 WHEREAS, Section 163.08, Florida Statutes, et seq., establishes Florida's
9 Property Assessed Clean Energy ("PACE") program, which allows property owners to
10 apply to PACE program administrators to finance certain qualifying improvements;

WHEREAS, Broward County adopted various consumer protections as conditions
to program administrators being permitted to enter into financing agreements with
property owners, including disclosure and income-based requirements;

WHEREAS, these protections are currently located in various portions of the
Broward County Administrative Code and the Broward County Code of Ordinances
("Code"); and

WHEREAS, the County wishes to reorganize the applicable PACE provisions in a
single location in the Code for the convenience and benefit of both program administrators
and property owners utilizing the PACE program, NOW, THEREFORE,

Section 1. Sections 22.175 through 22.177 of the Broward County
Administrative Code are hereby repealed in their entirety.

Section 2. Severability.

If any portion of this Administrative Code Resolution is determined by any court to be invalid, the invalid portion will be stricken, and such striking will not affect the validity of the remainder of this Administrative Code Resolution. If any court determines that this Administrative Code Resolution, in whole or in part, cannot be legally applied to any individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance, such determination will not affect the applicability of this Administrative Code Resolution to any other individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance.

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Section 3. Inclusion in the Broward County Administrative Code.

It is the intention of the Board of County Commissioners that the provisions of this
Administrative Code Resolution become part of the Broward County Administrative Code
as of the effective date. The sections of this Administrative Code Resolution may be
renumbered or relettered and the word "resolution" may be changed to "section," "article,"
or such other appropriate word or phrase to the extent necessary to accomplish such
intention.
