Calvin, Giordano, & Associates, Inc., CHA Consulting, Inc., CRJ & Associates, Inc., F&J Engineering Group, Inc., Rummel, Klepper & Kahl, LLP., and Tectonic Group International, Inc. submitted Letters of Intent (LOI) with their bid response indicating their DBE participation. These firms are in compliance with the DBE program requirements of the solicitation. CRJ & Associates, Inc. submitted incomplete LOIs for Program Controls, Inc. and Tierra South Florida, Inc. dba TSFGeo, however they committed to self-perform 33% of the scope as a DBE and are compliant with the DBE program requirements.

A/E Engineering, Inc., (A/E) originally provided a Letter of Intent (LOI), which was incomplete. This firm was given three (3) business days to complete and resubmit this form. A/E resubmitted its LOI within the required time and is compliant with the DBE program requirements of the solicitation.
