21 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
22 BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

23 Section 1. Section 21.31 of the Broward County Administrative Code is hereby
24 amended to read as follows:

25 **21.31. Purchasing Card Program.**

26 The Director of Purchasing is authorized to establish and administer a County
27 Purchasing Card (P-Card) program for the efficient expenditures of funds within the
28 guidelines of this Code, subject to the following:

29 (a) County Commissioners, Commissioner aides, and Commissioner office
30 direct staff are ineligible to participate in the P-Card Program subject to the provisions of
31 the P-Card Program Policies & Procedures Manual and the limitations of this section.

32 Authorized County Commissioner's aides and direct staff may use P-Cards only to
33 purchase office supplies, airline tickets, pay registration fees, or confirm hotel
34 reservations (but not to pay hotel expenses) for approved travel for a County
35 Commissioner or ~~his or her~~ their staff. Each Within five (5) business days after a P-Card
36 charge by a County Commissioner, Commissioner aide, or Commissioner direct office
37 staff, the County Commissioner's office shall provide to the County Auditor a copy of all
38 requests for payment through a P-Card within one (1) business day after use of the card,
39 along with copies of all documentation relating to the purchase or reservation confirmation
40 P-Card charge. For purposes of this subsection, "office supplies" means consumables
41 normally used in a government office, and small office equipment with a unit cost of \$100
42 or less. Items of a decorative, capital, or personal nature, including, but not limited to,
43 furniture, appliances, electronics that exceed \$100, break room supplies, any type of food
