A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING APPROPRIATION AND DISBURSEMENT OF FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF CHILDREN AND FAMILIES ("DCF") GRANT FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$420,162 TO SPECIFIED SERVICE PROVIDERS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2022-2023; AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE AMENDMENT #0004 TO DCF GRANT CONTRACT #JP003 AND AGREEMENTS WITH SPECIFIED SERVICE PROVIDERS, AND TO TAKE ALL NECESSARY ADMINISTRATIVE AND BUDGETARY ACTIONS TO IMPLEMENT THE AGREEMENTS; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Children and Families ("DCF") has awarded Broward County ("County") funding under Grant Contract #JP003 for housing projects to assist individuals and families experiencing homelessness, and for administrative support to the Homeless Continuum of Care ("HCOC") governing board and its subcommittees;

WHEREAS, DCF and the County desire to amend Grant Contract #JP003 to add three one-year renewal periods, beginning with the DCF grant period commencing July 1, 2022, through June 30, 2023 ("FY2022");

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Broward County, Florida ("Board"), desires to authorize the Broward County Administrator ("County Administrator") to execute the amendment to Grant Contract #JP003 and to execute new agreements with service providers specified in Attachment A for (i) emergency shelter services, (ii) rapid rehousing services, and (iii) rent payment assistance;

WHEREAS, the Board also desires to authorize the County's Community Partnerships Division to provide housing, programs, and/or services included in the

1 HCOC plan to help individuals experiencing homelessness obtain housing; and to provide
2 administrative support to the HCOC governing board and its subcommittees; and

3 WHEREAS, the Board finds that the services to be funded benefit the residents of
4 Broward County and serve a public purpose, NOW, THEREFORE,

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6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
7 BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

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9 Section 1. Authorized Appropriation and Disbursement.

10 The Board hereby authorizes appropriation and disbursement of FY2022 funds in
11 the aggregate amount of Four Hundred Twenty Thousand One Hundred Sixty-two Dollars
12 (\$420,162) as set forth in Attachment A.

13 Section 2. Execution by the County Administrator.

14 The County Administrator is hereby authorized to execute Amendment #0004 to
15 DCF Grant Contract #JP003 on behalf of the County. The County Administrator is further
16 authorized to (i) execute new agreements with the service providers identified with an "N"
17 in Attachment A, in substantially the same form as the applicable Board-approved form
18 agreement; (ii) take all necessary administrative and budgetary actions to implement the
19 agreements commencing July 1, 2022; (iii) provide (through the Community Partnerships
20 Division) housing, programs, and/or services included in the HCOC plan as specified in
21 Attachment A; and (iv) provide administrative support to the HCOC governing board and
22 its subcommittees, as specified in Attachment A. Nothing in this Resolution alters the
23 requirement that agreements be reviewed for legal sufficiency by the Office of the County

1 Attorney before execution. Any material deviations from the applicable Board-approved
2 form agreement must be presented to the Board for approval.

3 Section 3. Severability.

4 If any portion of this Resolution is determined by any court to be invalid, the invalid
5 portion will be stricken, and such striking will not affect the validity of the remainder of this
6 Resolution. If any court determines that this Resolution, in whole or in part, cannot be
7 legally applied to any individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance, such
8 determination will not affect the applicability of this Resolution to any other individual,
9 group, entity, property, or circumstance.

10 Section 4. Effective Date.

11 This Resolution is effective upon adoption.

As Broward County is retaining the Challenge Grant and the Staffing Grant funds, a separate service provider agreement and amendment are not applicable.
