

**PROPOSED**

RESOLUTION NO.

1 A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD  
2 COUNTY, FLORIDA, PERTAINING TO THE BROWARD COUNTY TOURIST  
3 DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL; AMENDING SECTIONS 12.1 AND 12.2 OF THE  
4 BROWARD COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE CODE (“ADMINISTRATIVE CODE”) TO  
5 PROVIDE THAT COUNCIL MEMBERSHIP AND TERMS OF OFFICE ARE SET FORTH  
6 IN THE BROWARD COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES; AND PROVIDING FOR  
7 SEVERABILITY, INCLUSION IN THE ADMINISTRATIVE CODE, AND AN EFFECTIVE  
8 DATE.

10 WHEREAS, Section 125.0104(4)(e), Florida Statutes, authorizes the  
11 establishment of a Tourist Development Council; and

12 WHEREAS, Section 31½-8 of the Broward County Code of Ordinances sets forth  
13 the Broward County Tourist Development Council membership requirements and terms  
14 of office, NOW, THEREFORE,

15 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF  
16 BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

17 Section 1. Section 12.1 of the Broward County Administrative Code is hereby  
18 amended to read as follows:

19 **12.1. Tourist Development Council.**

20 The Broward County Tourist Development Council (the “Council”) established by  
21 Ordinance No. 80-70 shall have all the powers and duties authorized under that  
22 ordinance, as amended, and Section 125.0104, Florida Statutes.

23 Section 2. Section 12.2 of the Broward County Administrative Code is hereby  
24 amended and replaced in its entirety to read as follows:

26 **12.2. Council Membership and Term of Office.**

27 The members of the Council shall be appointed and shall serve terms of office as  
28 set forth in Section 31½-18 of the Broward County Code of Ordinances.

29 Section 3. Severability.

30 If any portion of this Administrative Code Resolution is determined by any court to  
31 be invalid, the invalid portion will be stricken, and such striking will not affect the validity  
32 of the remainder of this Administrative Code Resolution. If any court determines that this  
33 Administrative Code Resolution, in whole or in part, cannot be legally applied to any  
34 individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance, such determination will not affect the  
35 applicability of this Administrative Code Resolution to any other individual, group, entity,  
36 property, or circumstance.

37 Section 4. Inclusion in the Broward County Administrative Code.

38 It is the intention of the Board of County Commissioners that the provisions of this  
39 Administrative Code Resolution become part of the Broward County Administrative Code  
40 as of the effective date. The sections of this Administrative Code Resolution may be  
41 renumbered or relettered and the word “resolution” may be changed to “section,” “article,”
